Corporate Supply Chain-related ESG/Climate Policies and Dispute Resolution – Call for Panellists

Taking in particularly into consideration existing and upcoming EU law (e.g. the Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive) having extraterritorial effects, contractual cascading and international commercial arbitration will be required to implement and enforce those policies along international supply chains.

The seminar’s target audience are C-level executives, in-house counsel, lawyers, academics and students.
